- o map ceramic knowledge across Europe,
- o assess the salience of practice to place,
- o build a visual and oral record of specialist processes and techniques,
- develop methods to effectively share this knowledge across the teaching and expert network to ensure heritage crafts skills are relevant to future practice.

Decoding Ceramics is a comprehensive and ambitious project, which gathers knowledge and expertise and makes it open and useful to all learners and teachers, at whatever level.
